

Motor Sports can be Dangerous and may involve Injury or Death

You must read and agree to the following declaration and paragraphs below which are designed to create a legally binding relationship in return for your being allowed to enter and compete.

It is most likely (weather permitting) that the Senior Support non-championship and/or Junior Support non-championship will be run after Practice on Saturday evening. Some of the Classic races may also be run after Practice on Saturday evening.

Concussion: The "Concussion Protocol" 2016 will be applied at this event. It is the competitors responsibility to read and understand the Concussion Protocol.

**Support riders in their second year can enter open races at all events subject to availability on grids at each event.
Support riders in their first year on the roads are restricted to Support only. Maximum of three races for all support riders.**

It is the responsibility of the competitor to present for scrutineering machines and protective clothing which are safe in all aspects and comply with the general competition rules of the MCUI.

1. All helmets for use on the day must be personally presented to the scrutineer on the day by the competitor.
2. I declare that the foregoing particulars are true and complete to the best of my knowledge.
3. I further declare that I have read the Rules and Regulations governing the event and agree to abide by them.
4. I admit the right of the promoters to refuse and entry without assigning a reason.

1. confirm that the information in this entry form and the information and my acceptance of the terms of my competition licence are correct.
2. I confirm that I understand the nature of the competition I am entering and I am competent to take part.
3. I confirm that any vehicle that I use will comply with the regulations and will be safe and fit for use in the competition.
4. Will satisfy myself (by sighting lap or otherwise) before taking part that the venue and track is acceptable to me with regard to its features and physical layout (unless prohibited to do so).
5. I will NOT take part if I have any doubt about my ability or the safety of the venue.
6. I accept that competition in motorsport may involve the risk of injury or death and I agree to take part at my own risk.
7. Before taking part in the event I will read and be bound by and comply with any regulations and final instructions issued by the organisers, the circuit owners and the regulatory body.
8. I Will not participate whilst under the influence of alcohol or intoxicating drugs and that if I am taking any prescribed medication I will inform the event organiser and seek approval to participate before taking part.
9. If under the age of 18, my parent / guardian has read the above and signed the declaration and agreement below.
10. I have read and understand the Concussion Protocol.

"In consideration of this, my entry, I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified, the Motor Cycle Union of Ireland and promoting club(s) (including the owners or lessees of land used for the event) and their respective officials, servants, representatives or agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death or loss of or damage to, the persons or myself, my passenger or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with my entry or my taking part in this event, notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the said bodies, their servants, representatives or agents, furthermore, in respect of any part of this event on grounds where third party insurance is not required by law, this agreement shall, in addition to the parties named above, extend to all any other competitors and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims costs and expenses and demands in respect of loss or damage to the persons or property of myself, my driver, passenger or mechanic(s)".
